Calsonic Kansei Corporation (Headquarters: Kita-ku, Saitama City, Saitama; President and CEO: Hiroshi Moriya) has been recognized by the Saitama Labour Bureau at the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare as a “corporation that supports childcare,” having conformed to the standards set out in the Act on Advancement of Measures to Support Raising Next-Generation Children(*). Consequently, Calsonic Kansei has been awarded the “Kurumin” in recognition of its support for the next generation.

*About the Act on Advancement of Measures to Support Raising Next-Generation Children

In response to the rapid decline in birthrates in Japan, the act came into force in 2005 in order to support the healthy development of the children who will lead the next generation of society (from the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare website).

Since 2011, Calsonic Kansei has implemented various bottom-up initiatives aimed at realizing greater diversity for employees in every region, with the intention of creating a more effective working environment for all our employees. The corporation’s “General Employer Action Plan” was drawn up to conform with the Act on Advancement of Measures to Support Raising Next-Generation Children, and the results of these internal initiatives have now been officially recognized.
